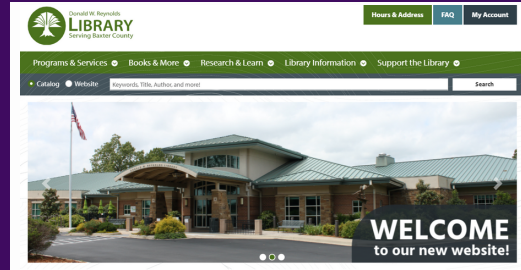


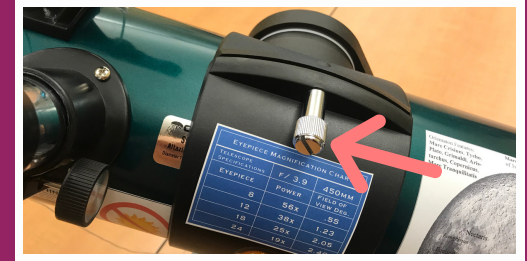


# How-to: Orion Telescope

Loosen and re-tighten tube clamp on black holder to adjust telescope position.

02



Twist to turn on EZFinder and red light will appear. Turn telescope to align red dot with the target object.

03



Remove caps from telescope tube and eyepiece. Set eyepiece on 24mm to have widest view of the sky. Adjust focus as needed using knobs.

## Have fun!



When finished with the telescope, put both caps back on, turn off the EZFinder, and store at room-temperature in a dry location until returned to the Library.

# Helpful tips: Orion Telescope

The telescope should always be held by the base. Do not take apart telescope or clean any of the lenses. The Library will take care of sanitizing once returned.



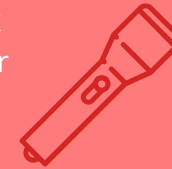

Familiarize yourself with stickers on the telescope - they are full of very helpful information that will make your viewing experience even better!

Use Nite Ize LED red light to see telescope in the dark and read stickers/instructions. White lights are harder for your eyes to adjust to and add more light to the area than the red does.

The sky is constantly moving. If an object disappears from the viewing area when looking through the telescope, try adjusting the telescope position little by little to find the object again.

Never look at the Sun!!! It is harmful to view through a telescope; protect your eyes.
